Amendment II

A well regulated Militia, being necessary to the security of a free State, the right of the people to keep and bear Arms, shall not be infringed.



Richard Henry Lee was born in Westmoreland County, Virginia, on January 20, 1732. He was the oldest of four boys and the seventh of eleven children. His brothers were Frances Lightfoot Lee, William Lee, and Arthur Lee.

Richard Henry Lee was educated at a private school at Wakefield in Yorkshire, England. He returned home after schooling in 1751.

In 1757 Richard Henry Lee was elected Justice of the Peace. He got that position for wanting peace between the British and the Americans.

Richard was elected for the Virginia House of Burgesses in 1758. There he served for seventeen years. In 1774, Richard Henry Lee was elected to the Continental Congress. He served for five years there. He was one of the best speakers in congress.

On June 7, 1776, he made his famous proposal to congress:

"That these united colonies are, and of right ought to be, free and independent States; that they are absolved from all allegiance to the British crown; and that all political connection between them and the State of Great Britain is, and ought to be totally dissolved."

He made the first move toward independence from Great Britain. Some of the delegates were still a little queasy about declaring independence from Great Britain: it was one of the most powerful countries at that time. The colonists didn't think they could win a war against such a powerful country, so the congressmen decided to write a document declaring their independence from Britain. The document had to state reasons why they wanted to be independent. They choose five people to write this paper: Thomas Jefferson, John Adams, Benjamin Franklin, Roger Sherman, and Robert R. Livingston. Thomas Jefferson wrote most of the declaration.

On July 1, 1776, there was a big debate in congress. Nine colonies voted for independence. South Carolina and Pennsylvania were against independence. Delaware's delegates were stuck in a tie. On July 4, 1776, Congress adopted the Declaration of Independence. Both Richard Henry Lee and his brother, Francis Lightfoot Lee, signed the Declaration.

In 1783, Richard Henry Lee was elected President of Congress. He opposed the federal constitution, because he favored the rights of states. He was also elected the first state Senator for Virginia. Later on, he returned home due to illness, and soon after died at the age of sixty-three in 1795.

Richard Henry Lee was an influential man. Other people thought he was a great man, too, because people in Virginia named a town after him and the whole Lee family. The town is called Leesburg, Virginia.

Is The Second Amendment Just About Guns?

Over the years many in our organization have been adamant about keeping SACFLA pure and just sticking to issues of firearms legislation, gun news and gun ownership. This was supposing that gun ownership was the only goal of SACFLA since we were not a militia. 

Because of pressure from the grassroots, four out of the seven gun-control provisions originally included have been removed, including:

- federal grants to fund firearm seizures;
- a new form of “red flag” gun confiscation orders; and
- an expansion of the Lautenberg misdemeanor gun ban (a.k.a., the “Boyfriend Loophole”).

Removal of the so-called “boyfriend loophole” has made the anti-gun White House and the far-left FURIOUS.

In fact, Biden was on national TV giving a speech about gun control just last week and, you guessed it, he was plugging the so-called “boyfriend loophole,” even while this deal was being cut!

Unfortunately, three terrible anti-gun sections are still included in this new VAWA. If this bill passed, the ATF would:

- **Work with your local law enforcement to launch criminal investigations into each NICS denial—which 9 out of 10 times is a false-positive denial of a law-abiding citizen.**
- **Begin deputizing local law enforcement and attorneys to act as agents of the ATF.**

Remember our last national alert where we told you the *NICS Denial Notification Act* was moving in the Senate?

Well, here it is in the *Violence Against Women Act*, which is potentially headed to the Senate floor for a vote!

As the only no-compromise gun lobby in Washington DC, GOA will only stand down when all the anti-gun provisions are deleted or the whole bill crashes and burns.


Taking out four of the seven unconstitutional provisions is a step in the right direction, but that's not good enough.

Florida has 42 counties, three cities and one town that have adopted Second Amendment Sanctuary (or other pro-Second Amendment) resolutions by the most recent information I could find. Currently Palm Beach County is not among the adopters of any 2 A Sanctuary resolutions and the prospects are that they never will adopt any.

So, our only hope is to have a declaration made on the State level. There were several bills put forward this past Legislative session but none of them made their way out of committee. These bills will be reintroduced in the next session and we will have to be vigilant and apply all the pressure we can muster to have these laws adopted.



Gun Safety Rules


1. Always assume the gun is loaded

3. Never point a gun at anything you do not intend to destroy
4. Always keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot
5. Know your target and what is beyond it


